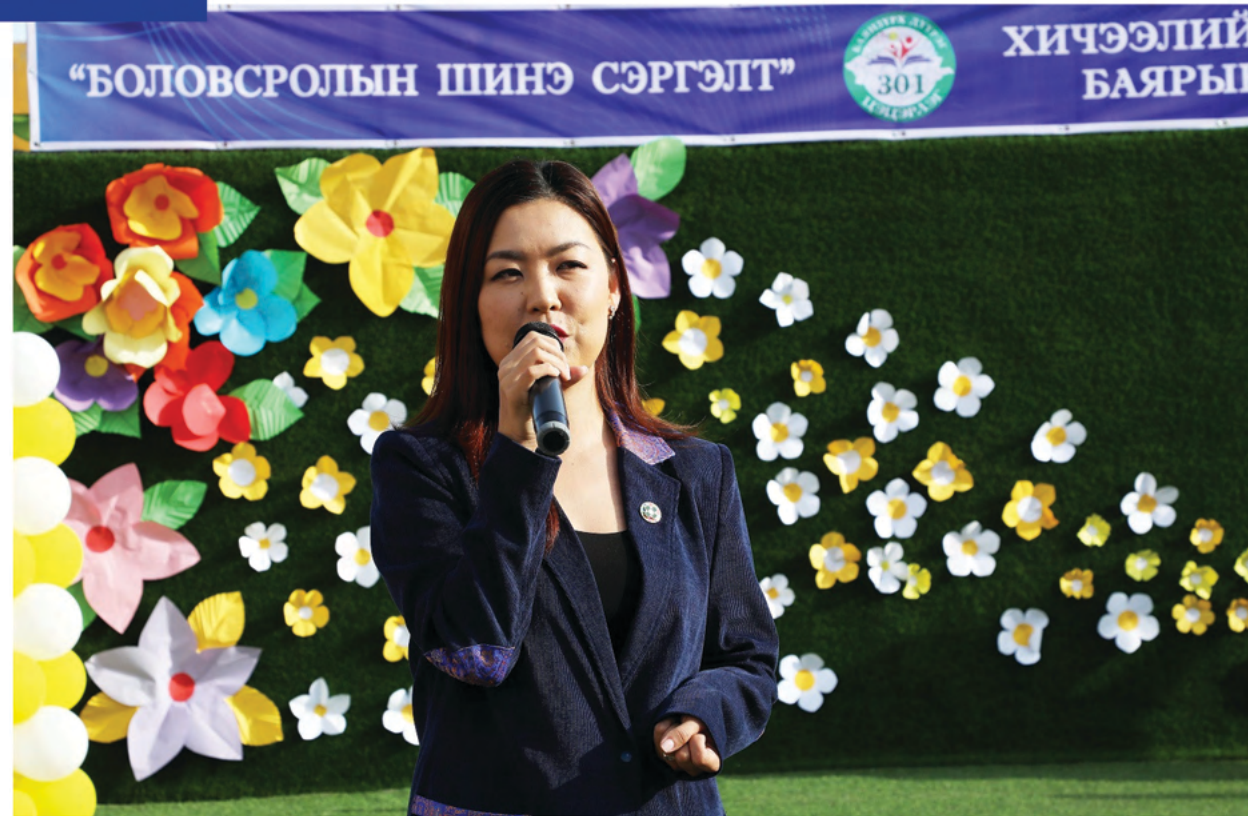

KHAN BANK CONTINUES TO SUPPORT THE ONE BILLION TREES CAMPAIGN

VIRTUAL MINE LAUNCHED BY TRANSWEST MONGOLIA

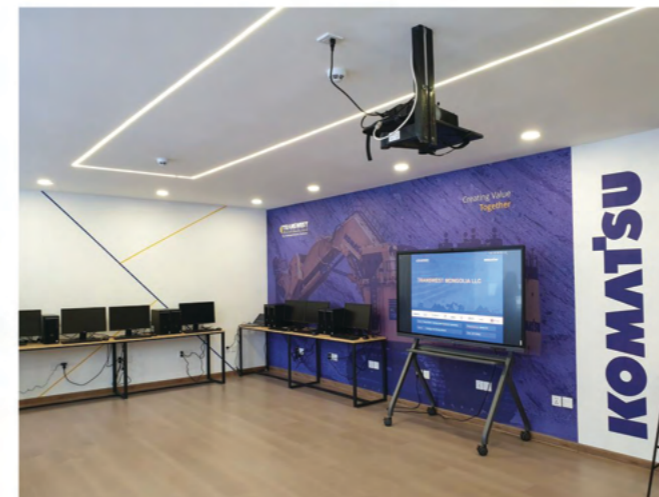
The Transwest Mongolia LLC Virtual Mine room for virtual technology training and practice opened with a ceremony at SHUTIS-GUUS.
