



AmCham Mongolia's U.S. Doorknock 2023 was successfully organized



WASHINGTON, D.C., USA - The American Chamber of Commerce in Mongolia (AmCham Mongolia) held its 7th annual Doorknock, visiting Washington, D.C., from June 7-9, 2023, with representatives of the U.S. Embassy in Mongolia and member organizations.

AmCham Mongolia's Doorknock delegation included representatives from AmCham members Altai Holding, Capitron Bank, Faro Foundation NGO, High Payment Solutions, Melville & Erdenedalai, Mongolian Mortgage Corporation (MIK), ONDO, Sendly NBFI, Seruun Group, and Trade and Development Bank. Joined by Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary Richard Buangan, the delegation met with senior U.S. officials from the U.S. Department of State, Department of Commerce, Development and Finance Corporation, East-West Center, the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative, U.S. Department of the Treasury, U.S. Chamber of Commerce, US EXIM Bank, and the National Security Council. Meetings were also held with the Mongolian Embassy in the U.S., and members of Congress.

During these meetings, several high-level talking points were presented, such as Mongolia's democratic governance and market economy, the challenges and opportunities facing the strengthening of economic and trade relations between the two countries, upscaling investment, Mongolia's geopolitical characteristics, and the important role of the United States in the third neighbor foreign policy. The delegation also talked to U.S. representatives about opportunities to attract financial resources.
